Kenseth Tops Wallace In Darlington

DARLINGTON, SC. – Roush Racing’s Matt Kenseth claimed the win under the lights Friday night at the Darlington Raceway to claim his first win of the 2005 season. Kenseth took the top spot over a hard-charging, hungry Kenny Wallace, who hasn’t won a Busch Series event since the 2001 season.
